

Competitive Program Overview

The Blitzz competitive soccer program is for kids who want a more challenging soccer experience than the recreational program. Approximately 200-300 players participate in the club's competitive program each year. Competitive teams travel to other Montana communities and nearby states to compete against like-minded clubs. The spring season runs from March to June and culminates with state championship tournaments. The club also offers summer soccer camps with guest coaches, a fall training camp, and a winter indoor soccer league.

The Blitzz coaching staff is one of the most experienced and highly qualified in the region. All coaches are United States Soccer Federation (USSF) certified and many have advanced licenses. The Blitzz Technical Director holds a USSF B license and also is a coach with the Montana Olympic Development Program. Members of Bozeman High School's coaching staff also work with our younger age groups during the spring competitive season. Many of these players have gone on to win state championships with the Bozeman High Hawks.

The success of the Blitzz competitive program is reflected in the number of kids who have continued to play soccer in college and beyond. The club has also produced many championship teams that have competed in USYSA regional tournaments.
